

FOUNTAIN BEARS A CLOSER LOOK

mma Jane Harley, 4, left, and cannine companion Emily Rudy, were among hundreds who gathered in Berkeley Sunday to celebrate the restoration of the Marin Circle Fountain, a 1910 landmark removed in the late 1950s after a traffic accident. Neighborhood residents raised \$85,000 to recreat the fountain, originally designed by John Galen Howard. Local architect Robert Ludlow used early photographs and incomplete drawings and documents to do the job, with sculptor Sarita Waite replicating the four grizzly bear cubs, acanthus leaf finial and volutes.
